Craig R. Sweet, M.D., a Reproductive Endocrinologist, has 61 abandoned frozen embryos. The reasons for the abandonment remain unclear since the parents cannot be found. The fate of these abandoned embryos remains uncertain.

Dr. Sweet and Rabbi Diamond will be speaking on this topic on Friday, September 21, 2001, at 7:30 PM, Temple Beth El, 16225 Winkler Road in Fort Myers.

It is undecided if the embryos should be destroyed, donated to needy couples or given to science for such procedures as stem cell research. The ethical, moral, legal and religious perspectives will be discussed.
